IMPROVEMENTS & RESOURCES

Included are two small buildings, one being a bunkhouse and a shower house. The ranch is also equipped with a heavy duty set of steel corrals.

One electric well runs a pipeline through the whole ranch that runs 6 water tanks, 4 in the deeded acres and 2 in the BLM allotment all in good working condition. Pipeline water is supplemented with 5 reservoirs.





RECREATION

The Ranch's BLM allotment borders over 60,000 acres of BLM and State land that eventually leads to the Charles M. Russell National Wildlife Refuge. This is a hunters paradise located in the 700 district which holds record breaking Bull Elk and Mule Deer, and also inhabits Whitetail, Antelope, Wild Turkey, Sage Grouse and Pheasants.
